

Hollywood Now Chapter Meeting Minutes for September 19, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Chapter President John Erickson.

- I. The meeting started with all attendees introducing themselves
- II. John provided a **Legislative Update** on actions the Chapter is sponsoring, and said these bills are now headed to the Governor's Office for signing (or rejecting). For more info, please see detailed information on the Hollywood NOW website.
- III. John provided an update on the Chapter's upcoming production of **The Vagina Monologues**:

 - Select cast (all requests to participate should be submitted to John and Karen for review)
- IV. John provided an update on the upcoming **LA Advocacy Training Project**, which the chapter is supporting / promoting. Next session will be "How to Write an OpEd," which John and Karen strongly recommended for everyone interested in learning about writing opinion pieces and getting their name in the media as a women's rights advocate. Date is Sunday Oct. 22 from 2:00-5:00 p.m. at NCJW-LA.

 - John talked about the Transgender Day of Remembrance event that is produced annually in November by the West Hollywood Transgender Advisory Board, and said there is a volunteer opportunity for chapter members at the upcoming event on November 20 in West Hollywood.
 - John also discussed the chapter's sponsorship of the event "Tea with Alice and Me" (more info TBD).
 - Karen provided information on webinars related to the upcoming March for Black Women, which the chapter is supporting, and the next meeting of ROAR, the West Hollywood chapter of Indivisible.
 - Karen also shared several bills being sponsored by NCJW-LA that are asking for citizen action.
